

**AGUEDA I. JOHNSTON MIDDLE SCHOOL (AIJMS)  
COMMUNITY LEARNING CENTER (CLC)**

- WHAT:** AIJMS CLC provides after school accommodations to enable students to use technology devices to have access to the Internet, print and scan documents for educational purposes.
- WHERE:** AIJMS's Cafeteria/Dining Hall
- WHEN:** Starting March 22, 2021, from 3:30 pm to 7:30 pm on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Fridays of every week, except on holidays.
- WHO:** Students in K-12 grade levels are welcome to use the Community Learning Center.
- CHAPERONES:** Students 13 years of age or younger must be accompanied by an authorized person who is at least 16 years of age. Authorized persons must present a photo ID and an authorization letter from a parent/guardian granting the authorized person permission to chaperone the student.
- REGISTRATION:** Each student/chaperone must register before each visit. Students and chaperones will have the following options to reserve dates/times to use the Community Learning Center:
1. Registration Form: Fill and submit before the visit or at the site. Registration form may be obtained from AIJMS' office or at the CLC.
  2. Call-In: Call 472-6785 to reserve dates and times to use the CLC.
  3. Walk-In: Walk-In student/chaperones will be accommodated on a first come first serve basis based on availability of space and after all pre-registered students/chaperones are accommodated.
- HEALTH/SAFETY:** Public Health safety protocols for COVID-19 are required including sanitizing of hands, wearing of masks, temperature check, physical distancing of 6 feet, and sanitizing of commonly touched areas.
